

BOARD OPERATIONAL GOALS

At the beginning of each fiscal year, the board shall formulate goals and objectives. The goals and objective may include, but are not limited to, its structure, visions, accountability and advocacy.

At the conclusion of each fiscal year, the Board shall reflect on the degree to which the goals and objectives have been accomplished by conducting a Board self-evaluation and engaging in Board developmental activities.

The Board's primary responsibility is to establish those purposes, programs and procedures that will best produce the educational achievement needed by district students. It is also charged with the wise management of resources available to the district.

In accordance with these principals, the Board shall seek to achieve the following goals:

- 1) To concentrate the Board's collective effort on its policy making and planning responsibilities.
- 2) To formulate Board policies which best serve the educational interests of each student.
- 3) To provide the Superintendent with sufficient and adequate guidelines for implementing Board policies.
- 4) To maintain effective communication with the public the Board serves and with staff and students in order to maintain awareness of attitudes, opinions, desires and ideas.
- 5) To conduct Board business openly.
