

BOARD MEMBER CONDUCT

Individual School Board members have no authority; they have authority only when acting as a Board, through official votes. With these legal considerations in mind, Board members shall conduct themselves as follows:

Attend all scheduled Board Meetings insofar as possible, and become informed concerning the issues to be considered at those meetings;

Make policy decisions only after full discussion at publicly held Board meetings;

Delegate authority to the superintendent as needed to carry out School Board policies;

Expressions of public reason to Board policies and school programs, shall be relayed to the Superintendent and other Board members;

Abide by the Board's policy on conflict of interest;

Respect the confidentiality of information that is privileged under applicable law or is received in confidence.

Remember always that their concern is for the educational welfare of the students.
