

RULES OF ORDER

Except as otherwise provided by law, by regulation of the State Department of Education, or by the Board, meetings of the Board shall be conducted in accordance with Robert's Rules of Order, revised. However, the Rules of Order may be waived on any subject by majority vote of the Board members present and voting provided that a quorum is present at the time of the vote.

Except as provided in RSA 91-A with respect to open meetings and minutes, and the First Amendment relative to public comment, there are few requirements in statutes or regulations which dictate how a board should conduct its meetings.

A school board meeting is a meeting at which the Board conducts its business. While board meetings are open to the public (except as provided under RSA 91-A:2 and 3), board meetings are not public hearings where the public has the right to speak. Public comment at board meetings shall be governed by Board Policy BEDH.
